**SENATE ACT 10-23**

**TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR AMERICAN SOCIETY OF CIVIL ENGINEERS FALL  
2022 RIO FUNDING EVENT**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

To appropriate funding for the Fall 2022 RIO Funding Cycle. The RIO funding process includes completing an application by deadline, attending a mandatory orientation, an interview with the Finance Committee representative, and submitting required forms as well as presenting an itemized budget. All RIOs receiving funding have met all deadlines and requirements.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$1,200.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325242 (RIO Funding Account).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

ASUH shall be recognized as co-funding the events at said events and on all advertising with the phrase “partially funded by ASUH.” Partial funding of said event shall not constitute co-sponsorship by ASUH. ASUH neither implies nor accepts any liability as a result of partially funding said event.

ASUH shall be recognized as a co-sponsor of these events.

All funding for the line items for “Food/Food Supplies” shall not go towards alcoholic beverages.

All RIO's are required to use their funding for the benefit of undergraduates at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa.

Due to the ongoing pandemic, the past community service requirement has been temporarily modified to follow state guidelines. Community service is not required this Funding cycle.

All funded events must comply with state and federal guidelines relating to the COVID-19 pandemic.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 4, 2023 shall lapse into RIO Account #3325242.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
