<i>Advisor Manini</i>	Kevin came to me today about this. So I gave him the verbage to address for the account. There is nothing in the rules that allows RIO's to come to Fall Funding to fund a spring event. It was clear that committee addressed it.
<i>SAL Mitsui</i>	I would like to fix for the funding for the club I am under. For Young Americans for Liberty. We initially applied to rent out the entire ballroom for this event. But, the finance committee only awarded us to use one-third of the ballroom apparently that is not enough. We would like to rent out two-thirds of the ballroom, which would cause to be \$200. I move to change the venue rental to \$140 to \$200.
<i>Senator Baxa</i>	The committee agreed on fully funding them for their venue. Its just they asked a little to much. There is a miscommunication with funding the venue, which is \$200.
<i>Senator Baxa</i>	Motion to add under Young Americans for Liberty on venue to add \$60 and reflect changes.
<i>Senator Hinshaw</i>	Second

<i>President Zakimi</i>	I just wanted to thank the Finance Committee for sitting through 18 hours of interviews.
<i>Advisor Manini</i>	When Kevin and I met briefly I asked him which of these funding are for Fall and Spring. So the treasure and office know how to process it. So I ask to identify those.
<i>Senator Omokawa</i>	Is that necessary I checked with the Treasurer and it was fine.

<i>Advisor Manini</i>	It is not fine because we need to identify which one expires in December and May. They have different guidelines.
<i>Senator Omokawa</i> <i>Senator Lao</i>	Motion to add semester specific for RIO before RIO award packets go out. Second Motion carries
<i>Senator Ryan</i>	Do we need to put something in there for the spring will lapse on the account?
<i>Advisor Manini</i>	It is already on there.
<i>Senator Candelario</i>	The only thing I am concerned about is if RIO is asking for funding for the same event for next semester. I feel they shouldn't be able to do that.
<i>Senator Candelario</i> <i>SAL Callihan</i>	Motion to add a provision of RIO's not being able to be funded for the same event for the next semester funding cycle. Second
<i>Senator Omokawa</i>	This is for RIO applying for funding for same event?
<i>Senator Candelario</i>	If I am part of an RIO for an event for this semester and apply again for the same event for next semester. I don't think it is fair for my RIO to be awarded for the same event even if it's a different semester just to get more money.
<i>Senator Garma</i>	I don't think the committee will allow that but it would not hurt to put a provision
<i>SAL Mitsui</i>	We should also say it shouldn't overlap for SAPFB funding as well.
<i>Treasurer Takara</i>	I don't quite agree with it because all these events are not the same in nature. For example the engineering events some of the conferences and events are quite big and represent the school. Lets say a lot of the events don't just ask for venue, or food. But also shipping and material cost. And having more flexibility to apply should be beneficial to RIO's don't just add for those.
<i>Senator Kim</i>	I agree with Treasurer Takara we should look at this case by case. For next semester they are able to reapply and less people if needed we can give it to those RIO's for big ticket items
<i>Senator Candelario</i>	I feel that you are already given an itemized list and go based off of that, but it comes down to applying for a conference for this semester So I can come back next semester and fund for the rest of it. I feel like it's not fair.
<i>Treasurer Takara</i>	We will take it in to consideration for RIO funding. If we funded you for that event in the fall we will put you on the bottom of the funding list. Everyone who needs funding will get funded first. Maybe there will be some left over or anything.
<i>Senator Omokawa</i>	The flexibility will also allow us to be more generous in spring then fall.
<i>Advisor Manini</i>	This is really a slippery slope. We never did awarded spring funding from the fall. There are no rules stopping you from doing it. I understand what Senator Candelario is saying. I realize that you did not use your \$32500. I realize you didn't give your RIO fall funding more money its about perception.

Senator Kim Just to let you guys know I went to the list quickly and there are only two RIO for spring. Those who applied for spring is American Society for Civil of Engineering 2016 Southwest Conference and second RIO Nakao 2016_____

SAL Callihan I disagree with the idea not restricting them will make us more generous. We would go back and award then RIO more. Next time we should focus by semester.

Senator Bui Pham I agree with Senator Candelario because, two things we want to avoid is double dipping and I agree with Bonny this perception that you can get spring funding in fall and create loop-hole with other RIO's. The fact we didn't do spring amounts in fall. I agree with Senator Callihan we should just stick to awarding by semester.

Senator Ryan We can to set a precedent for the fall and spring they can apply for funding in the fall for a spring event and same goes with spring for the fall. Or we can also go with they just have to apply for funding for that specific semester.

Senator Simeroth Was it necessary for two RIO's to get funding before spring?

Senator Omokawa Yes, I believe they were asking for expenses to build their project for their event.

President Zakimi The motion on the floor to add on a provision that for RIO's who are awarded for spring events this fall funding cannot apply again in the spring for funding.

Senator Simeroth I think these two were using funds for a necessary matter. The motion is not necessary

Senator Garma I do think its not cool they applied for the spring. It was not announced that we could apply for Spring. I agree with Gabe, we should limit it in the spring. For spring they should not apply for any more materials. Lets go with Gabe's motion they are not able to apply anymore. I hate to do it but it's to be fair with everyone else.

Senator Simeroth For a case like this it is time sensitive, it means they are will not be able to be funded at all.

SAL Callihan But, there was left over funds. Didn't we give them without restrictions and they shouldn't reapply again because they got what they desired?

Treasurer Takara One way we can see this is these particular events only happen once a year. Other RIO's ask for socials and retreats that happens' twice a year, which differs greatly.

Senator Ryan Why are they applying for fall but not for spring? They need it in the spring. Its fall funding not spring funding. We could change it to only say we fund for the fall

Senator Kim The reason why we should leave it because, it makes it more complicated if the event dates are in spring and funding them in the fall. I guess its hard to differentiate which we are trying to fund is the event dates in the spring and

Advisor Manini I just wanted to remind you all that motion on the floor is on adding the provision

Senator Bui Pham Just to clarify we are not allowing funding for same event in the spring.

Senator Simeroth It's not necessary to add the provision.

- Senator Candelario* The only thing I see is, I feel adding the provision will keep RIO's from funding for the same event twice in the fall and spring to get more money. I really do feel we should just add the provision
- Senator Omokawa* What about the RIO's who applied event before the award packet went out? This semester we added a precedent that if the event happened before October 23 they we were not going to fund them.

<i>Senator Sevilla</i>	It is important to know the purpose of event is super important, but the Purpose and funding for event are two separate things. The reason we are spending so much on food to keep people around.

- Senator Sevilla* We spend so much for shirts and on homecoming. What if we decrease the amount for games and got rid of the T-shirts entirely. What if we did a more interactive event?
- SAL Mitsui* I think we should abstain from tweaking for the allocations of items. This is what the committee came up with from past experiences.
- Senator Baxa* I understand that the issue is money. And campus life have a lot of time to think of the allocations. We also didn't special order this bill. For the T-shirts we are giving it to students who donate five cans. Last years we gave out shirts to people at the event and to the people who donated cans. We are cutting back on t-shirts. I don't think we should strike the numbers.
