SENATE ACT 32-17

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR CORDS COMMEMORATING ASUH SENATE SERVICE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

Each semester, the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa commencement ceremony serves as a time to recognize graduating seniors and their individual achievements as undergraduates. As stated in Rule 62 of the ASUH Revised Rules 2016, “[i]f budgeted for, every student that has served on a Senate can and may receive an item commemorating their time served.” Rule 62 Subsection (b) further stipulates that “[s]tudents not serving in the Senate at the time of their graduation, but who have served in a previous Senate, will receive a cord.” The purpose of this bill is to appropriate funds towards the purchase of such cords for qualified individuals.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$300.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account 3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).
