SENATE ACT 10-26

TO ALLOCATE FUNDING FOR ACCESS RIO BLOCK PARTY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

To allocate funding to support the Spring 2026 ACCESS RIO Block Party. A cross-college community-building event designed to increase visibility of RIOs and those that operate within ACCESS, strengthen collaboration across colleges, and create an engaging and welcoming campus environment.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$3000.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (_____) section(s) C2

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

This allocation is pending the approval of the FY26 ASUH Budget.

This event shall not take place at the same time as an officially scheduled ASUH General Senate Meeting or Executive Committee Meeting.

ASUH shall be recognized as a co-sponsor of this event alongside CSS's ACCESS, KTUH, and Phi Gamma MU. All funding is pending approval of the ASUH budget by the OVPSS.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 1st, 2025, shall lapse into Senate Account #3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION IV. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
