BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

ASUH is collaborating with the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to engage with students about their services and range of scope at the UHM. DPS is intended to provide students techniques on protecting themselves against violence and encouraging competency to handle potential threats. The ballroom will be split into various sections for different personnel to display breakout sessions. Food will be provided at the ASUH office by participants providing a voucher after completing activities.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$840.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services, and Support).

SECTION III. PROVISIONS

Refreshment tickets will be also used for additional events.

ASUH shall be recognized as a sponsor of this event.

The ASUH Committee, External Affairs, shall be in charge of advertising this event.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 6, 2022 shall lapse into Senate Account #3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION IV. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
