- Secretary Tagaban* Well he asked for a laptop, but we felt that giving him the amount of a laptop is too much. We funded him something equivalent to the processor.

Senator Candelario Second
- Senator Kim* It’s not a upgrade because he wants a new laptop. He wanted to buy a new laptop but we funded him what is equivalent to a processor.
- SAL Mitsui* My concern we normally fund registration, lodging and airfare. It’s not something that will last forever. My concern is we do not do that sort of funding.
- SAL Dela Cruz* The thing is he only needed the computer to do his research project. There is no other equipment for his research project. Going back to UAA vision, we are going back to help students.
- Senator Simeroth* The reasoning is funding for his own laptop. This appropriation is going towards an upgrade which is not necessary for his research project.
- Senator Samiano* He needs the whole processor, but including the computer it self. For the processor put into another computer we are funding the whole thing. We are not funding him for the whole laptop, but a portion of it.
- Motion does not pass
- Senator Simeroth* I think it is a little unclear why we are giving a \$213 appropriation for a entire computer. Which is suppose go to a research for a high processing power.

- Senator Samiano* Just to justify going on what SAL Mitsui is saying is we do not want to fund him something he can use after his research. We are just funding them a partial for his research. We are funding him for what he needs for his research.
- Senator Aki* How did you make the decision to fund a part of the computer?
- Senator Sevilla* This is what we based it off from a portion of the computer. This is a general idea of it.
- Senator Hinshaw* Is he buying physically a new computer separate from. After his research could he donate his computer to the school when he is done with his project?
- Senator Kim* He said he new computer with a faster processor. In which we based it off that to give him the amount for a processor. Donating it I'm not too sure. The computer he might be looking at is \$1500 in total and so \$213 is a small portion he would be paying out of pocket
- Senator Aki* My thing is if I'm doing a research project and my screen breaks. They will use the money to fix that and there is so much grey area.
- Senator Caramat* UH doesn't have the means to give him the funds for it or just by us?
- SAL Dela Cruz* this is his own project. I guess UH doesn't have the means.
- Senator Candelario* This is literally the part of his computer needed for his research.
- SAL Mitsui* It doesn't really matter what the applicant is saying. We are providing him with an upgrade and he gets to keep the computer. I don't think we fund for these kind of events.
- Senator Simeroth* I agree with SAL Mitsui and Senator Aki. It is not plausible to upgrade a laptop.
- Senator Barrow* This will help him with his research. What percentage of his research will help us? Why doesn't he ask his college to him to purchase a computer for their students? Geo funds and oceanography they have computers for them to use.
- Senator Samiano* Our argument was we justified it is he was going to post his findings with his AMSUH group online and so any other students interested in his findings they can use it.
- Senator Caramat* I just think computer is too vague. Is there more way we can get clarification?
- SAL Callihan* We do not know if there is somewhere he can do this work on campus? I think this is a grey area.
- SAL Dela Cruz* So the reason he wanted to a high processor was used to collect all his data. If he used a computer on campus he would not be in possession of his own research.
- Senator Baxa* Was there anything else he was requesting money for maybe you can just appropriate those funds there?
- SAL Dela Cruz* So initially he asked \$1500 stipend, but we can't fund stipends. We tried to ask him many times if there was anything else he needed funding for and the only thing that came up was a high processing computer.
- Senator Candelario* I just wanted to know when he does his research does ASUH get credit?

- SAL Dela Cruz* For UAA we wanted to share the recipients works and in the past ASUH has been recognized as a sponsor.
- Senator Simeroth* Going back to the fact \$213 will be a valid amount. For a processor that is hyper threaded for the software to run faster, it actually worth more then that
- Sentaor Kim* For something that what he is doing. He needs it to be portable to carry his research from school to home.
- Senator Lawi-an* Why doesn't he carry an external hard drive?
- Senator Kim* We did not ask him that, but based off of personal use of a computer the external hard drive to computer maybe slower
- Senator Candelario* But going back to our vision statement is to empower students through advocacy. A research thing like this, students are doing good. Who wants to do research on their spare time? \$200 is \$200. Let him keep the computer I mean he could inspire others to do research. It's a \$200 thing.
- SAL Dela Cruz* Branching off Senator Candelario and Samiano. His research will benefit the university and people will access it and see it.
- SAL Mitsui* If we set a precedent when people are applying for funding by saying will fund you for anything even if you get to keep that item.
- Senator Ryan* We are funding conferences and they get to keep that knowledge. I don't think it makes a difference.
- Senator Simeroth* For specifically for funding a laptop. All those laptops are hyper threaded.
- Senator Hinshaw* You guys are 100% sure he can do his research here and carry his data from here to home using an external hard drive.
- Senator Kim* Just to clarify hyper threading just means (Insert the intellectual thing he said about computers).
- Senator Omokawa* Keep in mind he pays that ASUH fee. None of us can use that funding we have to offer. I feel like this is something small and its within our budget. Motion to call to question
