Chairperson Candelario I just wanted to introduce Julie from Blood Bank of Hawaii.

Julie Thank you for inviting me to your meeting. I really want to say thank you for taking on this endeavor and sponsoring our blood drive. If you didn't know UH Manoa has approved us to have a blood mobile every Tuesday. They have promised us a certain location but, they took that from us. So are working on securing a regular place. We will relocate the your drive for Tuesday. The drive is still happening. Did you know 2% of Hawaii residents donate blood and 60% of us will need blood somewhere in our lifetime. What we ask from donors is 1 pint of blood. Our requirements for blood donors is to be about 110 pounds, you need to hydrate and eat really well. Drink room temperature water. Test your blood and iron. If you 17 years old you need a parental consent form. After the mini physically, you get on our bed and to draw blood it takes 8-10 minutes and then rest 10-15 minutes. If you are taking a list of medications there are some certain medications that we cannot take your blood. Sign up a shift with Gabriel as soon as you can.

Senator Simeroth I have a few motions to make do we need to still have to get it the finance committee.

President Zakimi Special order goes straight to the senate so we do need to discharge anything.

Senator Simeroth Does anyone have any questions on the bill before I start making my motions? We have Teresa Bill here to answer any questions you have as well.

Senator Sevilla I just wanted to know what the promotional items are?

Senator Simeroth The first promotional item is the portable chargers. Teresa do you have any other things to add?

Teresa Bill Part of the promotional items is part of two different groups. So SPAM is asking for some and the veteran students. I always like things that students will use. So flash drives useful to those commuting a lot. Student Parents like the handsantizer holders, we are also interested in the pen that has three uses of a pen, stiles point and highlighter. We have thought of our group and I am in conversation with the veteran students. I did not have a chance to talk about what they think there demographic their office would. Those are the kinds of things. The portable chargers are most expensive. We would like to get a 100 to 150 items. The event also has things to pass out.

Senator Simeroth Motion to strike line items for large tents rental, promotional items for SPAM and OVCSS. Add a line item for promotional items for SPAM for \$2000 and a line item for OVCSS \$2000. Increase the line items for the prizes to \$1610. Decrease the amount for the line item to advertising to \$1072.50. Decrease line item for food to \$710. Decrease the amount to reflect the total changes to \$7690.50.

Senator Lao Second

Senator Simeroth We are taking the promotional items and separating it into two different line items for \$2000. There is a slight increase of \$10 and decrease. Does anyone need me to over the amounts again?

SAL Dela Cruz What was the new amount for food?

Senator Simeroth For food it is \$710.

SAL Dela Cruz Sorry for advertising.

<i>Senator Simeroth</i>	Advertising it is \$1072.50. These are the same numbers on the subtotals on the spreadsheet as well.
<i>Senator Candelario</i>	Is ASUH the co-sponsor for this event?
<i>Senator Simeroth</i>	We are the co-sponsor for this. One thing we are planning to do with their advertising is trying to get an area on the flag where we can put our own ASUH logo. But, the thing I like about the flag other then the rest the other advertising is the flag is reusable. Motion carries.
<i>Senator Barrow</i>	If the power banks are \$10 and if you want to buy 150 of them that is \$1500 I think that is a little strange.
<i>Senator Simeroth</i>	That wasn't a set amount. I believe Teresa went through discounts. In general they are pretty cheap. If you can get 100 at the most, and handsanitizers we can also get it for pretty cheap. This will also be separate from SPAM and OVCSS students.
<i>Senator Barrow</i>	If price that was the price for the promotional item, then it is not a good promotional item.
<i>Senator Simeroth</i>	It is not yet set and stone.
<i>SAL Mitsui</i>	Looking at spreadsheet for prizes and giveaways for the parking pass. I was wondering how this will be given out. I don't want this parking pass to be given to students not driving to school
<i>Senator Simeroth</i>	The elite parking spots are not on campus. It is down the street between university and king it is a separate lot. Teresa do you know how this prize will be given?
<i>Teresa Bill</i>	We have to give the name and information to the parking folks. So we definitely would know who needs parking. We are open to suggestions. We can do with they have to be present to win or please bring car registration. Most people who want this prize need parking.
<i>Treasurer Takara</i>	Would you know the demographics of how many non-traditional full time students at UH?
<i>Teresa Bill</i>	Probably half our population is non-traditional. Student parents there is about 700-800. Veteran students are another 1200. There are quite a few students who would be interested.
<i>Advisor Manini</i>	Teresa Full time aspect is important because full time students pay a fee.
<i>Teresa Bill</i>	My impression most of them are full time. Part-time students is another category of students.
<i>Senator Garma</i>	I like this event it is pretty cool. My only concern is promotional items is pretty large. I feels like its more than half of the whole budget its my only concern. We do not use that much money for our promotional items
<i>Treasurer Takara</i>	You have good promotional items giving out. Did you possibly consider reducing prizes?

- Senator Simeroth* Regarding promotional items amount I do understand half of the bill total. It is being distributed the amount fairly between student parents and veteran services Its not only the time that's being thrown away.
- Teresa Bill* I think both organizations are looking long term. One of the things about the promotional items is to increase visibility for the organization. Prizes that are something for people to come to the event. We are very thankful for whatever you have.
- SAL Mitsui* Are we co-sponsoring the event?
- Senator Simeroth* I believe we are co-sponsoring. Whatever this appropriation will not cover it will cover advertisements. We are also able to table at the event.
- SAL Mitsui* Motion to add under section III ASUH will be recognized as co-sponsors of the event.
Senator Candelario Second
Motion carries
- Senator Lao* Will the promotional items given to anyone who comes to event? We only represent to full time students of manoa.
- Teresa Bill* It is clear they need to be students. Full and part time students. Some of the prizes that students win will need to fill out a tax form.
- Senator Sevilla* Its awesome we want to celebrate non-traditional students. Issues a few of us are having \$4000 not for celebration, but to show people about organization. Maybe put in more money to celebrating the event. A permanent way to help non-traditional students maybe through a separate bill.
- Teresa Bill* We use the celebration to generate interest and use promotional items to use for long lasting services with students
- Senator Sevilla* The best way to get people to be familiar with the organization is give out a bunch of swag items.
- Senator Bui Pham* Going back to what Senator Lao was saying. Is there something to reevaluate what students to look if students are actually are full time, I recommend you use a id scanner.
- Teresa Bill* One of the things we are doing is having them show student IDs
- Treasurer Takara* Last year we passed the bill for the same event for \$4400 dollars would you know the amount of how many people attended?
- Teresa Bill* We have something similar in the spring, but this is our fall event we are not going to be doing it for every semester. We had about 200 students that came to the event. We did a head count and we asked for ID's to pass out bentos that was a resource fair.
- Senator Chenung* You can rent ID scanner from SLD. Would you want to rent ID scanner?
- Teresa Bill* Certainly
- Senator Candelario* There will be 62 prizes given out. You are going to be expecting 200 people there. It is going to be every 3 people getting prizes. This is more of a promotional item.
- Senator Samiano* How many are you going to order for the smart phone chargers?

Teresa Bill Minimum of 100 and its \$8 plus shipping and handling.

Advisor Manini Just a couple of things, when I saw this piece of legislation because of the amount not being looked at by finance. I asked Kelly why its being special ordered she said the promotional items need to be ordered. I was wondering if this could go to committee to be looked at and if September 23 is still too late for them to order to go in for senate to fund it.

Senator Simeroth Would it be okay for the funds to be available on October 2?

Teresa Bill If there is flexibility to be reimbursed that would be okay. If it needs to be paid by ASUH PO that would leave us three weeks for promotional delivery. Particularly I would be happy to do it on our fiscal end. If we need to order things, are office fronted our money and pay x dollar amount

Advisor Manini Reimbursing is not a problem, as long as we have the spreadsheet showing which amount paid for it. I think people are nervous about the promotional items amount. I think going to finance committee first would be better then it coming back to general senate.

President Zakimi Advisor Manini do we motion to have go to finance?

Advisor Manini Refer it to finance, then they make their suggestions and it comes back to the general senate.

Teresa Bill I certainly support transparency and people participating in the process. This is a tight crunch and I don't want people to feel rush for this process.

Senator Garma Motion to send senate bill 15-16 for review to finance committee and have it be reviewed during the next general senate meeting.

Senator Samiano I sympathize with them we are only giving them a month to order everything. We are only complaining about two items. The item I agree with is only the mini charge. For the other items I don't know how necessary they are. For shipping included it should be around \$1000- \$1200. Would \$2500 be okay with you guys?

Teresa Bill For us to share?

Senator Samiano You would have it at \$2000 each for SPAM and Veteran student services. So if you took out \$500 at each.

President Zakimi Sorry Senator Samiano but the motion we are discussing is the one on the floor at the moment. Is there any discussion for the motion at the moment? If you feel still want to discuss the bill you would naye your decision.

Senator Garma I retract my motion.

Senator Saminao Continuing with my discussion, would that be okay? The little stuff as important as a portable charger especially for non-traditional student. Would a total of \$3000 be okay?
