Dr. Noel Kent

Thank you for having me here. We have a responsibility of taking care of Social Sciences, Language and Literature, Arts and Humanities, and Natural Sciences. We have seen that some of our departments are in desperate shape because of a lack of positions. We have 55% of the students, but the problem is we are only getting 18% of the tuition, so we are sort of a cash cow for the research institutions. Many of you have to take the general education courses through these colleges, so we are sort of the foundation of the university. Back in the 90s, the English department had around 80 positions, now they have 34. Mathematics and Chemistry are also in the same situation. We have many people who contingent faculty, but they can't create an education experience because they don't have the time to have a commitment. We need to have a whole different formula for funding for the university. If you talk to the Dean of Arts and Sciences, they'll tell you that the departments are in a crisis, since students can't get into the courses they need to graduate. This directly impacts your constituency, which is why I came to you. We are putting a couple of resolutions to the legislature. President Lassiter is not interested in changing his game plan - he is very comfortable with hiring contingent faculty, and he doesn't want to put resources into the four colleges, and the Board of Regents has never quite been able to understand what real education is about. So we had to find a point of leverage, which is the legislature. The resolutions we are presenting are geared towards a new and equitable formula for funding the colleges. One resolution that runs through the House is urging administration for an equitable based budgeting model. We asked Senator Kahele to put another resolution through to align revenue sources, and to put the Board of Regents and the UH Administration accountable to the legislature for implementing this sort of program. I think it is important for students and senators to present testimony, since they will listen to students. The legislators are very considered with the quality of education given to students. We are presenting this as a crisis for the student body and the quality of education they are getting.

Senator Arenivas What would the President report to the Legislature?

Dr. Noel Kent They would be reporting what we are achieving.

SAL Enriquez Would it be possible to get a copy of the resolutions so we can write legislation?

Dr. Noel Kent Sure.
