**Senate Resolution 06-26**

**REAPPORTIONMENT OF ASUH SENATE SEATS**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE SENATE:**

*WHEREAS,* the Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Senate is the elected body representing approximately 14,000 full-time classified undergraduate students across all academic colleges at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa; and,

*WHEREAS,* the Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Constitution (Article IV, Section A, 2b) requires that a reapportionment of Senate seats be determined every three years by the ASUH President and approved by the ASUH Senate based on the current full-time undergraduate student population for each academic college, that there shall be at least 1 representative from each college, and the total number of College Senators must not exceed 30 members; and,

*WHEREAS,* the current undergraduate student enrollment data for each college in the 2025-2026 academic year was obtained from the Mānoa Institutional Research Office; and,

*WHEREAS,* due to institutional reorganization at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa, several academic units previously represented as separate schools or colleges are no longer designated as independent units for Senate apportionment purposes; and,

*WHEREAS,* changes in enrollment numbers and academic colleges, as reflected in the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Catalog, requires the restructuring of Senate seats allocated to each college to ensure equal representation of all full-time classified undergraduate students at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa; and,

*BE IT RESOLVED,* that the Associated Students of the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Senate adopt an updated reapportionment of Senate seats based on the current undergraduate student enrollment data and reorganization of academic colleges and schools at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa as follows; and,

**College Senators (Total Seats: 30)**

- College of Arts and Sciences: 16
- College of Education: 2
- College of Engineering: 2
- College of Tropical Agriculture & Human Resilience: 1
- Hawai'i inuiākea School of Hawaiian Knowledge: 1
- Shidler College of Business: 2
- School of Travel Industry Management: 1
- College of Health Sciences (John A. Burns School of Medicine; Nursing & Dental Hygiene): 2
- Thompson School of Social Work and Public Health: 1
- School of Architecture: 1
- School of Ocean & Earth Science & Technology: 1

*BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,* that this reapportionment shall be effective from the 2026 General Elections through 2029 General Elections, after which another reapportionment shall be conducted to take effect for the 2030 General Elections, in accordance with the ASUH Constitution and Elections Schedule; and,

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,* that copies of this resolution be transmitted to the ASUH President, ASUH Advisor(s), the Elections Committee members, and the ASUH Senate for implementation.
