SAL Mitsui Is the "monetary prize" the stipends?

Treasurer Takara For those who do not qualify for financial aid those are the stipend awards

SAL Mitsui So why are stipends not being awarded?

Treasurer Takara It's a form of income.

President Zaikimi This is something we looking into with the Director of Financial Aid. There is a federal

policy and we are going to asking how that policy is interpreting stipends.

Advisor Manini Across the university system we have been dealing with this challenge. In the past the

award and recognition through stipends used by CSO's across university system. During the past 2 years, the award packages are being force to be re-done if they are receiving any stipend. Financial will go back in to your award and readjust your award being paid back. The stipends exist to thank you for your service. If you are not a financial aid award then you are not affected. Grant and Kelly came to me before the budget was accepted by senate. The stipends are being looked at as a scholarship not income. If looked at income, it would not affect your financial aid. It would affect your income at the end of the year and taxes. It is being processed as a scholarship. Grant, Kelly and I

are trying to find a way to provide some options to recognize everyone.

SAL Mitsui The problem is its not being considered as income, but a scholarship?

Advisor Manini Because it is labeled stipend.

SAL Mitsui The revision will state the stipends are being granted for the volunteer service.

Advisor Manini We are going to try and run it through with this. The people who are going to look over the budget

and push through it we might be able to expedite it. We are trying to work on a system so that the

financial aid recipients are not penalized for an award for CSO.

Senator Cheung Do you in exact detail on how they put the stipends together, like a scholarship. How much will

you lose in your financial aid?

Advisor Manini Dollar for dollar.

Senator Cheung Because I'm receiving the stipend for the past year. Financial aid is not affected. How much will

I get if my FAFSA is affected?

Advisor Manini I am removed from seeing the process of Financial Aid, Healani does that. Your specific situation

I cannot look at it at the moment. You came on special elections.

Senator Cheung Yes. But I was not affected.

Advisor Manini It could be you were offered loans and did not accept them. But, I do not want to go much in to

detail at the moment.

Senator Cheung How is the calculation accepted to the stipend?

Advisor Manini Well it is hard to look at without looking at your exact situation.

SAL Mitsui I can try to answer that question. If you look at the cost of UH Manoa it is \$5000 hypothetically. If

FAFSA covers all of it, your at net zero. But, if you exceed the \$5000 by taking the stipend, then it

will affect your financial aid.

Senator Barrow If you did not accept all the loans from your financial aid would you receive your stipend?

Advisor Manini Well usually yes because you are not fully funded.
