Pres Watson We will be reviewing all reelection results

Advisor Healani You need to have two votes to be officially elected

Pres Watson We now have a treasurer, secretary, and all SAL positions are filled

A. Cash Awards

Pres Watson We will be giving out cash awards not pending the budget. We will be using our funds. First we need to get through prior fiscal year cash awards. Look through July and August as well as Sep

B. Committee Meeting

Pres Watson Talked to the staff senate and asked about interest in having the president or provost come in for a meeting about not pushing for private-public partnerships (P3)

VP Ziadeh Can they put money from P3 housing to self-operated housing?

Pres Watson President Wendy Hensel can but it is cheaper for the president to support P3. Potentially advocate for President Hensel to receive more state funding and work with other organizations to persuade President Hensel against P3 options

VP Ziadeh They have prioritized Freshman students which causes housing crises. They also have not renovated existing buildings

Pres Watson Make sure we bring in solutions, including no P3 agenda

Advisor Bonny We need a resolution

Pres Watson Have a meeting with President Hensel and have testimony with people in P3 housing (Rise and Haukani). It is unreliable and more expensive for students, additionally there is not sense of community

Advisor Bonny As you prepare to speak with staff, there needs to be a planning meeting to have open discussion. This will help with pros and cons with self-operated housing and P3

C. Interest Scooping of CSOs

Pres Watson The UH administration will take our interest yearly if there is money sitting in our accounts. This was a policy implemented last year without ASUH consent. This can be detrimental to sibling organizations as it will take away their money and go into the President's account

VP Ziadeh What do you mean by president?

Pres Watson ASUH's money, GSO, CCB, etc. money goes into the President's account. The reason being to push CSOs to use all of our funds

Advisor Bonny This can be different for various CSOs. If you believe there should be a person keeping track of interest than have some draft a resolution
