SENATE ACT 07-26

FUNDING FOR FORUM ON STUDENT ACTIVISM IN ERA OF MASS PROPAGANDA

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT SENATE:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

To allocate funding in support of an educational forum hosted by ASUH in April 2026. This forum will engage students in critical discussion on student activism in the United States and the ways in which governments weaponize education for purposes of militarization. This topic is directly relevant to the University of Hawai‘i at Mānoa, as the UH Student Senate previously passed SR 06-24, which called for the University of Hawai‘i to cease its designation as a University Affiliated Research Center.

SECTION II. APPROPRIATIONS

A total of \$4,400.00 shall be appropriated from Senate Account #3325232 (University Programs, Services and Support) Account C2 and C4 50% from each respectively.

This allocation is pending the approval of the FY26 ASUH Budget.

ASUH shall be recognized as a sponsor of this event. All funding is pending approval of the ASUH budget by the OVPSS.

SECTION IV. Any unexpended and unencumbered balance of any appropriation of this Act, as of the close of business on May 6, 2026, shall lapse into Senate Account #3325232.

SECTION V. The Treasurer is authorized to draw upon said account.

SECTION VI. This act shall take effect upon approval by the Senate.
